



# Pangea Day

**Pangea Day** is a global day of films, music and speakers that will be held simultaneously on May 10, 2008 in gathering places around the world. Inspired by the 2006 TED Prize wish of Jehane Noujaim, Pangea Day endeavors to bring the world together and promote understanding and tolerance. Pangea Day is a celebration of what unites us, rather than what divides us, via films made *by the world for the world*.

Pangea Day is a first of its kind, participatory event. Filmmakers of all levels answered an open call for films, generating more than 2560 submissions from more than 102 countries. In addition to live events to be held on almost every continent, everyone is invited and encouraged to host their own Pangea Day gatherings – in homes, schools, community centers, offices, town halls, backyards – simply anywhere people can gather and share.
