1. Any Nokia Eseries, Nokia Nseries or Nokia S60 3rd or 5th Edition device.
2. Mail for Exchange application preloaded or downloaded for free at www.nokia.com/mailforexchange, where you'll also find the latest list of certified and supported devices.
3. A flat-fee mobile data subscription from your operator.
4. A Microsoft Exchange (Outlook) email account.

How to set up Mail for Exchange on Nokia Eseries

On Nokia Eseries devices, Mail for Exchange is preloaded. Simply go to the email setup screen.

1. Click 'set up email'
2. Fill in your business email address and your password
3. Select 'Mail for Exchange' from the picklist and add:
 - server settings (ask your IT department)
 - your PC login and password (same as your desktop)
 - your data 'access point' (ask your operator or IT department)
4. Push email is active and emails are now automatically sent and received. You can also select which items and folders to synchronise.
